What is the cost for Farewell?

If you are paying by cash or check, please place your payment in an envelope with your child's name on the front with the word FAREWELL and have your child return the envelope to the front office. Please make checks payable to CMS.

What does the Farewell fee include?

The \$35 covers all costs of the end-of-year eighth grade items and events (T-shirts, program and reception, social (food, decorations, and DJ), picnic snacks, goodie bags, awards, breakfast).
