#### What to do if my child is absent?

- Email: <a href="mailto:CMSabsence@hcpss.org">CMSabsence@hcpss.org</a> or
- A signed parent note or doctor note is required when the student returns.
- Your child should <u>first</u> look at Canvas to see what work they've missed before contacting teachers

## What if I need to drop something off to my child?

- Drop off on left side of lobby

- Students can carry their backpacks to and from class and will take them to lunch and recess


#### Chromebooks


- New to CMS students will receive Chromebooks and chargers by Friday of the first week of classes.

#### **Online Safety**

HCPSS continues to invest in information security efforts, upgrade of equipment and ensure that our network is secure, and it is critical that our user groups – which include students, staff and parents/guardians – do their part to maintain a safe virtual learning environment.

#### **Google Meet Expectations**

To ensure a positive and productive learning environment during Google Meet online sessions, it is important that students and parents adhere to certain guidelines.

#### Lightspeed

Parents/guardians may elect to receive of htspeed weekly emails summarizing their student's HG of Chromebook internet usage. There also is an option for the Lightspeed Parent Portal, which provides near real-time information on a student's HCPSS Chromebook internet activity, and offers the ability to pause web browsing and block social media sites when not on the HCPSS network.

#### Virtual Responsibilities

A successful virtual instruction program requires collaboration and shared responsibilities among students, educators and families to ensure that every student is supported and has the best chance to learn and thrive.

#### **DIGITAL TOOLS**

HCPSS uses a number of digital tools to deliver educational programs and services, enhance educational experiences, and educate students about safe and effective online practices. A digital tool is any interactive website, application or software that requires an account with a username and password.

#### **Essential Digital Tools**

Essential Digital Tools are digital tools that HCPSS considers necessary to deliver educational programs and operational services that support the goals of the system. These Essential Digital Tools align with HCPSS curriculum standards and are 508 COMAR compliant.

Any digital tool or web application that is embedded in curriculum resources/materials and/or is endorsed/promoted by central office curriculum staff is considered an Essential Digital Tool.

#### Supplemental Digital Tools

Online educational resources that do not require an account to use, or are only for teachers' use.


#### **Google Additional Services**

#### Additional Technology Info

- The Lightspeed Parent Portal provides near real-time information on a student's HCPSS Chromebook internet activity and offers the ability to pause web browsing when not on the HCPSS network. 
